Tree Assessment Congress of is a novel initiative to exchange experience among professionals and learn from leading international experts. The event offers lectures, discussion panels and workshops by renowned specialists in Visual Tree Assessment and instrumental diagnostics, including international guests. The first Tree Assessment Congress will be held on February 14-16, 2018, in Wrocław. The highlights include:

Professor Andreas Roloff - a recognized expert in arboriculture, will present, among others, the latest interpretation of the widely known scale of tree vitality of his authorship.

Frank Rinn - the creator of the advanced technologies for tree diagnostics will share his rich experience in assessing the condition of trees by conducting a lecture and practical workshop.

Duncan Slater - a specialist in diagnosing tree forks, will present his observations during the lecture and leading a practical workshop.

The Congress is organized by the Tree Institute (Instytut Drzewa), together with partners - Wrocław School of Arboriculture and Treeclimbing Poland. The Tree Institute provides professional courses, including the Certified Tree Assessor course, as well as comprehensive tree assessment services.
