## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### § 1 ORGANISER

The organiser of the Tree Diagnostics Congress and accompanying events is Instytut Drzewa sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Wrocław, entered in the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for Wrocław-Fabryczna in Wrocław, VI Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS no. Court Register, under KRS number: 0000809306

### § 2 OFFER

1. The Organiser shall carry out the event within the scope and on dates described in detail in the offer available at [kongresdrzew.pl](http://kongresdrzew.pl)
2. The offer specifies: the scope, date, programme and venue of the event, as well as the amount of the participation fee. participation in the event.

### § 3 RULES OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation in the event is conditional on the availability of free places and on the participant completing an application form available on the Organiser's website no later than 7 working days before the start of the event.
2. The participant is obliged to complete the application form correctly and in accordance with the actual state.
3. In the event that the participant is a delegated employee, the completed application form must be filled in by the delegating entity and sent in the form of a scan by e-mail to the following e-mail address: [kongres@instytut-drzewa.pl](mailto:kongres@instytut-drzewa.pl).

4. Sending the form is tantamount to accepting the conditions of participation contained in these Regulations and has the character of a contract binding both parties to the training.
5. Each registered participant receives during the event a certificate of participation in the training.

### **§ 4 FEES**

1. Payment for participation in the event shall be made on the basis of the registration and the submitted VAT invoice with a fourteen-day payment deadline. The invoice is issued with the date of sale
2. The participant has the option to indicate a different method of payment. The willingness to change must be notified in the notes of the application form. The organiser may introduce discounts for the payment.
3. The organiser may introduce discounts or promotions for the event, in accordance with the terms of the offer.

### **§ 5 CANCELLATION**

1. Cancellation of participation in an event must be made free of charge up to 7 days before the date of the event and must be communicated in writing (by e-mail).
2. Cancellation within a shorter period of time or absence from the event will result in a 50% charge. W In individual cases, lesser costs may be charged.

### **§ 6 FINAL PROVISIONS**

1. The organiser reserves the right, in the event of circumstances beyond its control, to cancel or postpone the event, of which it will inform the participants at least two weeks
2. In the event that a participant has made a prepayment and is unable to take part in the proposed new date, the Organiser will immediately refund the monies paid.
3. Participants are obliged to familiarise themselves with these Regulations. Submitting an application form implies acceptance of the provisions of these Regulations, as well as an obligation to comply with the rules of order and any other arrangements made between the participant and the Organiser.

### **§ 7.PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA**

The PDC shall process the provided personal data in compliance with the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), on the basis of Article 6 (1) lit. (a) of that Regulation.

3. Data will be processed on the basis of consent given, for the purposes of keeping attendance lists, records and documentation of the event held. Your consent is voluntary, but necessary for participation in the event.
4. If the Participant gives additional consent, personal data will be processed by the Organiser in order to inform him/her about new trainings, publications and events carried out by Tree Institute Ltd.
5. The data will be processed until the consent is withdrawn or an objection to its processing is expressed. In fulfilment of the obligations imposed on the Administrator by generally applicable laws, the Administrator may archive the data or transfer it to third parties for the purpose of archiving, documentation or accounting for the event carried out. Personal data will not be profiled, processed in an automated manner or transferred to third parties outside the European Union.
6. Participants have the right to access the content of the personal data provided, the right to correct, complete, update, rectify the data, as well as the right to object to the processing of the data at any time, as well as to request its deletion. Participants also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection
7. In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.

### **§ 8. EPIDEMIOLOGICAL RESTRICTIONS**

1. Epidemiological restrictions will apply during the event, which participants are obliged to observe.
2. In the event of restrictions preventing the organisation of the event, participants will be informed immediately of changes to the programme (date change) or cancellation of the event. In the event of cancellation of the event, participants will receive a refund of the fees paid.
